- **Is this in person or virtual?**
 - In person. While we make rare exceptions for virtual workshops, we stress the importance of in person whenever possible.
- **What is the timeline?**
 - This is a year-round program. The goal is to get as many films and corresponding Q&As as possible, so we work around the schedule of the talent.
- **Where does this take place?**
 - The series takes place in the below prisons:
 - Chino prison just outside of L.A. [*California Institution for Men - 14901 Central Ave, Chino, CA 91710*]
 - Fishkill prison in New York [*Fishkill Correctional Facility - 18 Strack Dr, Beacon, NY 12508*]
- **Who coordinates travel?**
 - Cool Hand Series will coordinate all travel for talent and any accommodations necessary for participation.
- **Scheduling**
 - Chino Prison: We can hold a screening and Q&A any Tuesday evening or weekend. **Please note, weekend screenings need to be scheduled at least 3-4 weeks in advance to secure proper staffing at the facility.*
 - Fishkill Prison: We can hold a screening and Q&A any time Monday-Thursday and before 6pm Fridays. **Please note, screenings must be scheduled at least 2 weeks in advance to secure proper staffing at the facility.*
 - If none of the above times work, please let us know.
- **What kind of company is Cool Hand Series, Inc.?**
 - We are a 501(c)(3) non-profit that brings theater and films into prisons in California and New York. Our aim is to provide access to the arts for those incarcerated and awareness about our prison system to those in the entertainment industry as well as the general public.
